Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for your understanding during this unseasonably wet weather! We will always try and ensure that the children continue to swim wherever possible providing it is safe to do so.

I would just like to give a general reminder regarding our uniform policy which can be found on our website under the "About us" tab. In warmer weather, children may wear white or black sandals with white or grey socks. For health and safety reasons children are not permitted to wear jewellery other than a single pair of plain stud earrings. Hair must be the child's natural colour. Long hair must be tied back, for safety and hygiene purposes, with a plain hair bobble or dark band. Extreme hairstyles are not permitted. Hair ornaments of any type are not permitted. Use of hair products is also not permitted. Children are not permitted to wear makeup of any kind including nail polish except at school social functions e.g. Discos. Thank you for your co-operation and support with uniform.
