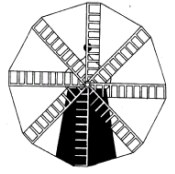




Heckington St Andrew's Church of England Primary School Newsletter

Please can you bring in Junk Modelling to make a Rocket for next Thursday (13th December). Thank you

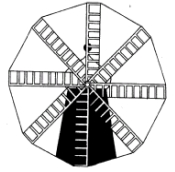
