


# Heckington St Andrew's Church of England Primary School Newsletter

As you are aware, we will be saying a very sad farewell to Miss Jennings at the end of this year; I'm sure you will join me in wishing her all the very best for the future.



# Healthy Minds Lincolnshire

Healthy Minds Lincolnshire have created a 5 part series on managing change called “Survival Guide to Change” and it can be found here:

This workshop series is **appropriate for children and young people aged 10+**. Families of children younger than 10 are welcome to watch the videos themselves to learn skills and strategies to share with their children. They would recommend that children around the age of 10 are supported by an adult with completing these workshops. The videos make some references to COVID-19, but the strategies can be used for coping with many different changes.

There is also a workshop to support parent/carers to learn new strategies to understand and support their child/young person presenting with anxiety and additional needs. This can be found on the same link above.

## How to order school uniform.

We recommend two uniform suppliers for our school uniform. Both of our suppliers provide a “Parent Online” ordering method.
