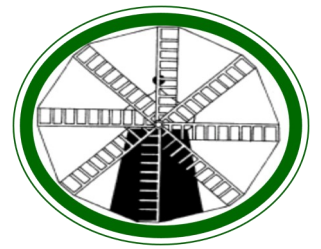


Heckington St Andrew's Church of England Primary School Newsletter

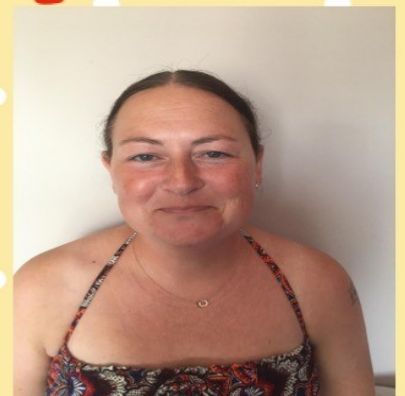

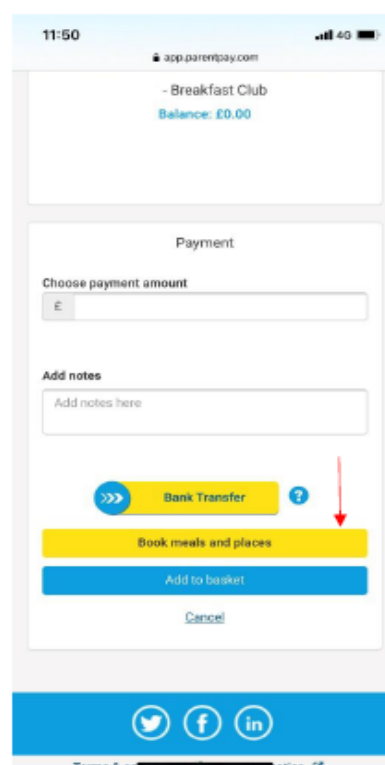

How to Book a place at Breakfast/AfterSchool Club

1. Login in to Parent Pay
2. Select your child's name and choose Pay for Other Items
3. Select the item you wish to pay for (Breakfast/AfterSchool club)
4. You should then see a screen similar to the screen below. You will need to click on **Book Meals and Places** (do not manually type an amount in).
5. Once you have clicked that you will be taken to another screen where you can choose 'Breakfast or AfterSchool' from a drop down and select the Week Commencing you wish to book places for. Then click 'Make or View Bookings'
6. If you scroll down you can see the free dates and you can choose the days you wish to book by clicking on 'Book a meal'.
7. When you have selected your dates you can scroll further down to 'Confirm Bookings' These will now be in your basket and you can checkout with your preferred payment method.
