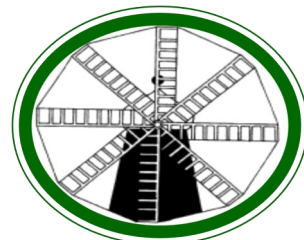


Heckington St Andrew's Church of England Primary School Newsletter

We have a growing pile of lost property from last term. Please come and have a look through as soon as possible. Any unclaimed items will be donated.

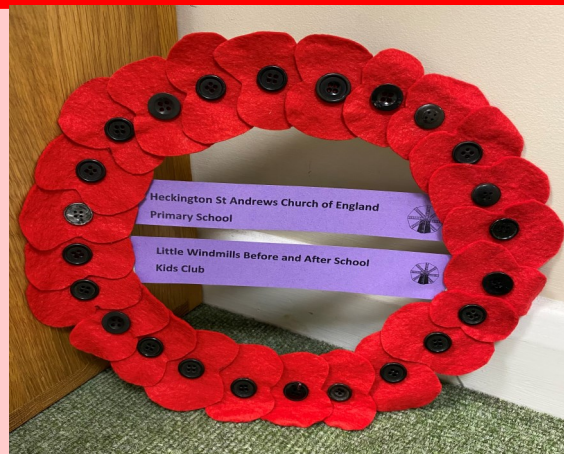
