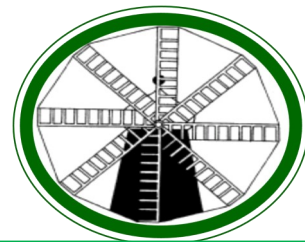


Heckington St Andrew's Church of England Primary School Newsletter

WHAT WE COLLECT

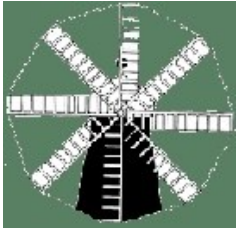
We accept the following '**good quality**' items for RE-USE*:
