For some of these schemes, it may take a few days before they are fully up and running so please keep checking back if you can't find us straight away. If you have any issues, or if your voucher scheme isn't on our list, please let us know so that we can register with your chosen scheme.

We are also in the process of setting up the government tax free childcare scheme but are having some issues obtaining the reference code we need in order to do this due to an error at their end. However, we are hopeful that this will be resolved early next week, and we will let you know when this scheme is available for you to use.

When you log on to your childcare voucher provider, you will need to select our school; you may need to search for our URN number which is 120526. Once we have received the payment for the vouchers, we will credit your Parent Pay account with that amount and you will be able to use this balance to pay for the before and after school club.
