



# Year 3 Curriculum Overview



<b>English:</b> Reading, spelling, grammar and writing	Weekly spellings (see Ed Shed for home practice) Guided Reading- retrieval, fluency, comprehension and ongoing inference and deduction skills Grammar focuses alongside our narrative writing will include a study of tenses, sentence structures and mastery of commas, inverted commas and relative pronouns.
<b>Maths:</b>	We will begin this term with a study of fractions. This unit will be extended to allow for deeper study including equivalent fractions, counting in tenths, adding and subtracting fractions. We will then move onto finding angles, identifying right angles, making turns and comparing angles.
<b>Design and Technology</b>	In DT, this term we will be making castles! We may ask for some donations of boxes again!
<b>Science:</b> Physics	In science we will be exploring the power of magnets and forces. We will learn about magnetic north, the laws of attraction as well as exploring forces between two objects.
<b>Physical Education</b>	Monday- netball Thursday- athletics
<b>Religious Education:</b> Christianity	Our big question this term is 'why do Christians call the day Jesus died Good Friday?'
<b>PSHE:</b> Relationships	We will be learning about healthy, positive relationships in our PSHE learning. We will identify what makes a good friendship and how to resolve conflict as well as helping others to be a part of a group.
<b>History</b>	We will be learning all about how children's lives have changed from Tudor and Victorian Britain to life as a child in the modern day.
<b>French</b>	In French, with Mrs Scott we will be learning how to play some playground games in French as we also learn French numbers.
<b>Music</b>	Music this term is all about Indian music,. We will learn the rag and tal and how a drone affects a melody. We will also experience some Bollywood music and dancing.
