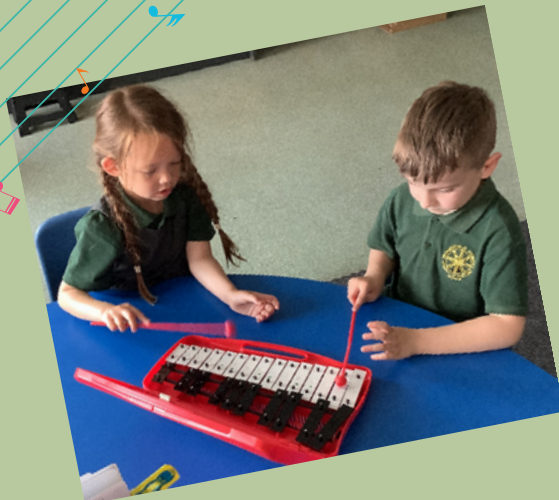
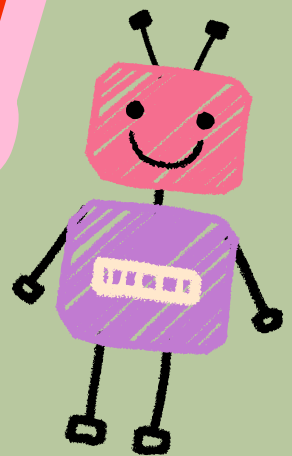


Maple Class!
