It has been a truly productive and rewarding few terms for our Gardening Club. The children have demonstrated exceptional dedication and enthusiasm as they worked diligently to revitalise and maintain our outdoor spaces. Their efforts have included weeding, planting, and general tidying—contributing to a significantly improved and more vibrant environment.

Through consistent daily watering and care, the children have successfully cultivated a range of crops. We are delighted to report a fruitful harvest of courgettes, radishes, and beetroots. In addition, our potato plants are showing great promise, and the tomato vines are beginning to bear fruit—much to the children's excitement.

Beyond gardening, the children have also enjoyed exploring the school pond, especially during the recent stretch of warm weather.
