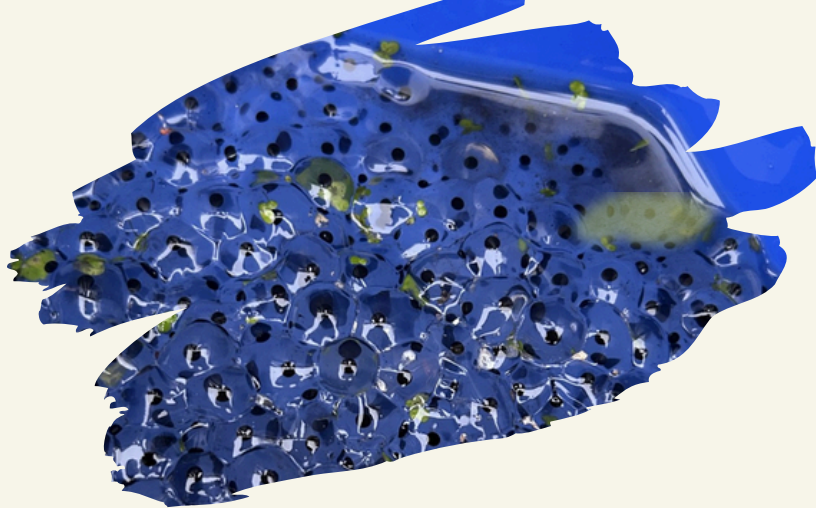

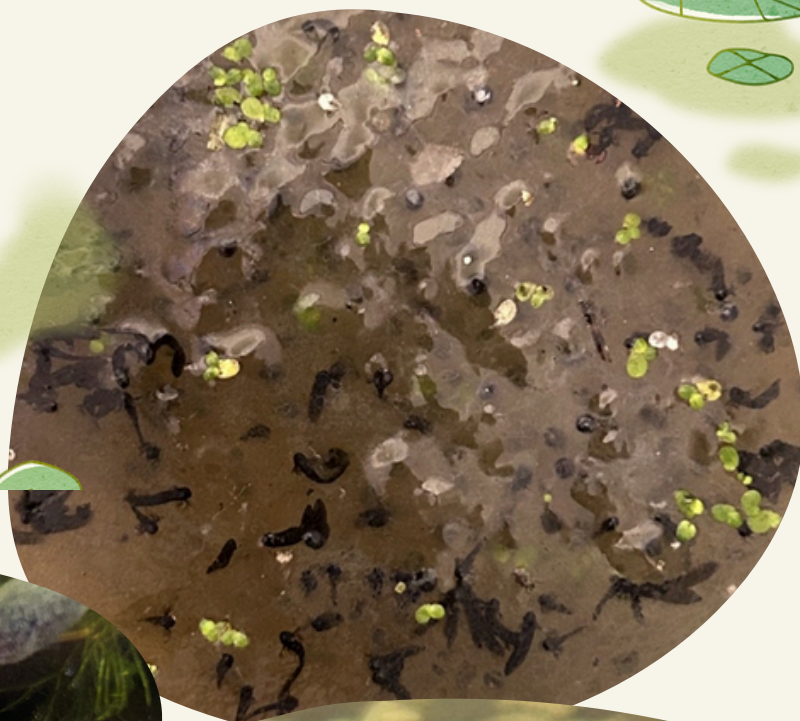
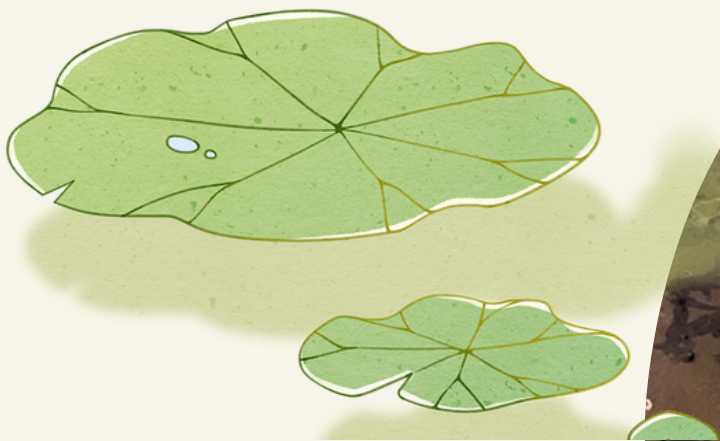
Chestnut Class
