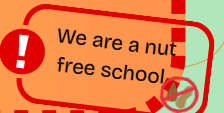


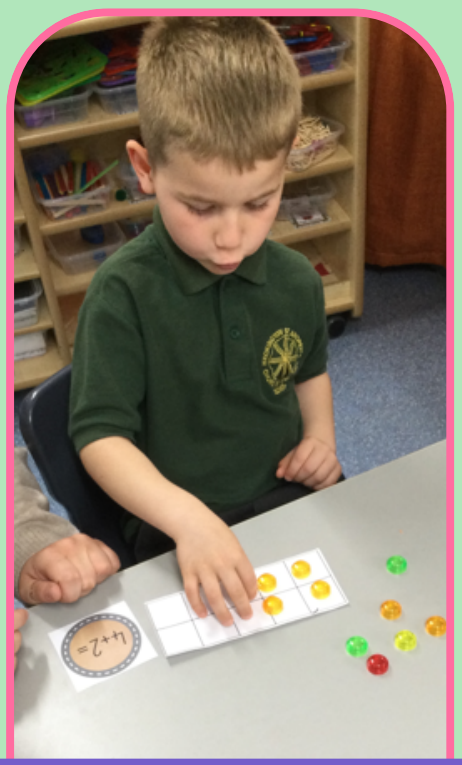
### OUR SCHOOL VISION
