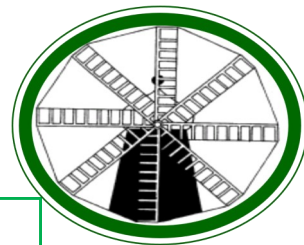


Heckington St Andrew's Church of England Primary School Newsletter

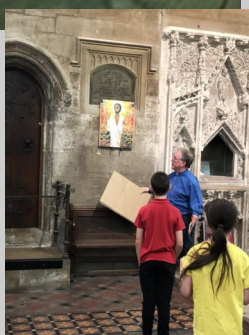
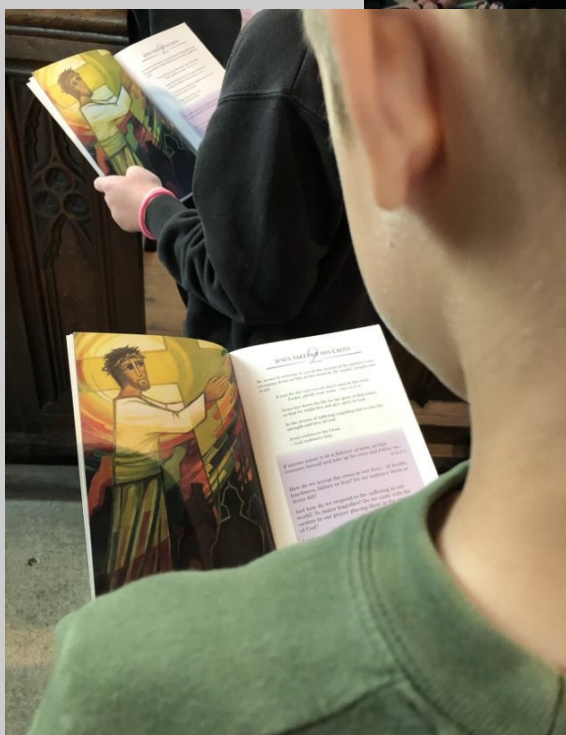

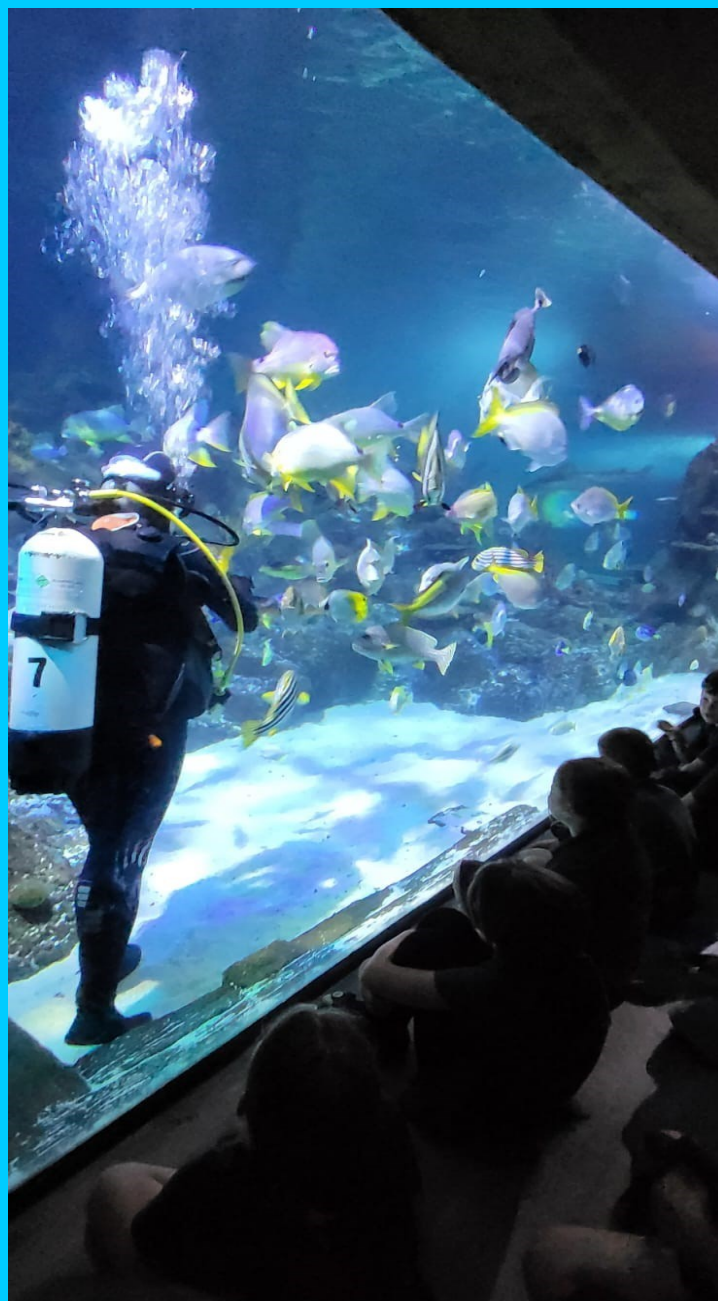
This fantastic picnic bench has been kindly made by Violet's Grandfather.. The children will enjoy using this for many, many years to come. A huge thank you from us all.
