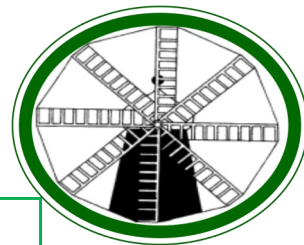


Heckington St Andrew's Church of England Primary School Newsletter

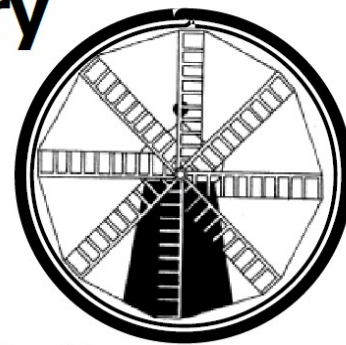
Here are some examples of our photography. The fruit is based on the artist Edward Weston who made art using close up monochrome photography called Macro Photography. .
